SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 71 - 88

An Ordinance to enact Chapter 1063 and Sections 1063.01, 1063.02 and 1063.99 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley authorizing the Board of Education for the City of Bexley to promulgate rules to provide for the safe, fair, reasonable and impartial management and control of its buildings, equipment and grounds and to provide a penalty for violation of such rules.

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley ("City") and the Board of Education for the City of Bexley, Ohio (the "Board") are concerned with the health and welfare of the children and youth of the City of Bexley; and

WHEREAS, the Board is responsible for the safe, fair, reasonable and impartial management and control of its buildings, grounds and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Board, in cooperation with the City, desires to provide in a safe, fair, reasonable and impartial manner its buildings, grounds and equipment for educational, social, civic and recreational activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO.

Section 1: That Section 1063.01, 1063.02 and 1063.99 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley be entitled "School Grounds, Equipment and Buildings" and be enacted to read as:

1063.01 DEFINITIONS

AS USED IN THIS CHAPTER:

(a) "BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY.

(b) "BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT AND GROUNDS", INDIVIDUALLY OR COLLECTIVELY, MEANS ANY PROPERTY OWNED, CONTROLLED, GOVERNED OR MANAGED BY THE BOARD.

1063.02 RULES OF CONDUCT FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT AND GROUNDS

THE BOARD MAY ADOPT ~~REASONABLE~~ RULES FOR THE PRESERVATION OF GOOD ORDER AND SAFETY ON AND WITHIN ITS BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT AND GROUNDS. SUCH RULES SHALL BE POSTED BY THE BOARD ON OR AROUND THE BOARD'S BUILDINGS, GROUNDS AND EQUIPMENT AND SHALL BE PUBLISHED AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 222.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY AND, UPON APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY, SHALL BE ENFORCED BY THE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT DURING THOSE PERIODS WHEN SCHOOL IS NOT IN SESSION OR AT SUCH OTHER TIMES AS MAY BE DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD. NO PERSON SHALL VIOLATE A RULE ADOPTED UNDER THIS ORDINANCE.

1069.99 PENALTY

WHOEVER VIOLATES OR FAILS TO COMPLY WITH ANY PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY RULE ADOPTED UNDER THIS CHAPTER IS GUILTY OF A MINOR MISDEMEANOR AND SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00).

Section 2: That this Chapter shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
