A Resolution in support of the 1989 COTA Levy on the November 7, 1989 ballot.

WHEREAS, the Committee to Keep Franklin County Moving has joined together individuals and organizations from throughout Franklin County to encourage the passage of the COTA Levy on the November 7, 1989 ballot; and,
