

ORDINANCE NO. 19 -89

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids for the purchase of regular leaded, regular unleaded and diesel fuel for the City of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into monthly purchase agreements with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of regular leaded, regular unleaded and diesel fuel to be used to supply the City vehicles and equipment.

Section 2. That the amount of \$65,900.00 has been appropriated and set aside in Ordinance No. 16 -89 for the monthly purchase agreements and that the agreements, as specified, shall not exceed the balance of the appropriation.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and so that bids can be secured for monthly agreements to purchase petroleum products. This Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
