

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 21-89

An Ordinance to appropriate \$2,800 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the payment of certain costs in connection with the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$2,800 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying the costs of refinishing certain furniture owned by the City for reuse in Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to have this project finished in time for the reopening of Jeffrey Mansion, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
