

ORDINANCE NO. 23-89

An Ordinance to transfer \$4,659 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate \$4,659 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the replacement of two water lines at Jeffrey Mansion and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$4,659 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That \$4,659 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of replacing two water lines at Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion at the earliest possible date, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
