

ORDINANCE NO. 28 -89

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley for the Mosquito Adulticiding and Larviciding Program services for the year 1989, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City for the Mosquito Adulticiding and Larviciding Program services for the year 1989, on such terms as shall be approved by the City Health Commissioner and the City Solicitor.

Section 2. That the contract authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to begin the program prior to the onset of warm weather, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
