

ORDINANCE NO. 29-89

An Ordinance to appropriate \$15,087.50 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion and to declare an emergency.

Section 1. That \$15,087.50 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the Capital Improvements Fund for the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion as follows:

- Item 1: \$1,989.50 40 chairs for the first floor and a transport cart
- Item 2: \$4,300.00 Office furniture: 2 file cabinets, 3 desk chairs, 4 bookshelves, 1 lamp, 12 side chairs, 4 chair mats, 5 bulletin boards and 1 typing table
- Item 3: \$4,500.00 Landscaping for the perimeter of the Mansion.
- Item 4: \$3,923.00 Replacement of two "I" beams under the grand staircase.
- Item 5: \$ 375.00 Tempered glass on four windows around main fireplace.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public place, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete renovation of Jeffrey Mansion by May 29, 1989, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
