

ORDINANCE NO. 35 -89

An Ordinance to authorize the transfer of funds within the 1989 Capital Improvements Program and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the sum of \$105,400.00 was appropriated for the purchase of one 25 cubic yard refuse packer truck; one dump truck; one snow plow, and one salt spreader; and,

WHEREAS, through competitive bidding, it was possible to purchase those items at a savings of \$19,786.00; and,

WHEREAS, a need for additional equipment has been demonstrated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$19,786.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the 1989 Capital Improvements Program for the following purposes:

Rustproofing new refuse packer and dump truck	\$ 1,500.00
Purchase of one truck-mounted air compressor and air jack	\$ 2,750.00
Purchase of one front end loader	\$14,000.00
Purchase of one postage meter	\$ 1,536.00

Section 2. That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to purchase equipment for the current construction season; and, therefore, shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
