

ORDINANCE NO. 40 -89

An ordinance to authorize the Auditor to accept mandatory drug fines and bail forfeitures payable to the City under Ohio Revised Code Sections 2925.03(J) and (K), to create the Law Enforcement Mandatory Drug Fine Fund and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the arrest and conviction of drug offenders is a concern of the citizens of the City of Bexley; and

WHEREAS, the City may receive funds pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 2925.03; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to accept mandatory drug fines imposed on or bail forfeited by convicted drug offenders in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Sections 2925.03(J) and (K).

Section 2. That there be and hereby is created the Law Enforcement Mandatory Drug Fine Fund.

Section 3. That the Auditor be and hereby is directed to place all cash received in accordance with Section 1 hereof into the Law Enforcement Mandatory Drug Police Department law enforcement efforts pertaining to drug offenses.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare, said emergency being that the City cannot accept such monies and property, and shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
