BY: ORDINANCE NO. <u>52</u>-89

An Ordinance to grant additional sick leave with pay to Douglas Napper and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Douglas Napper, an employee of the City of Bexley, has a broken hip as a result of an injury sustained while playing softball on a team comprised of Bexley employees; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Napper, in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code 4123.80(B) and 4123.01(C)(3), waived his rights to Workers Compensation or benefits under Chapter 4123 of the Revised Code; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Napper exhausted his sick leave benefits and vacation benefits and was granted additional sick leave for 20 work days pursuant to Ordinance No. 22-81; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Napper has requested 88 work days of additional sick leave for the period from August 22, 1989, through December 21, 1989; and,

WHEREAS, City Council is authorized by Ordinance No. 22-81 to grant extensions of sick leave benefits and it has been determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Bexley to grant additional sick leave to Mr. Napper. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Douglas Napper be granted additional sick leave benefits of up to 88 work days commencing August 22, 1989, and expiring no later than December 21, 1989, or the effective date upon which Mr. Napper is released to return to work by a qualified physician, which ever occurs first.

 $\underline{Section\ 2}.$ That this Ordinance is an emergency due to the sudden onset of injury to Mr. Napper and the need for long-term recuperation necessitated by the injury and shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
