

ORDINANCE NO. 58 -89

An Ordinance to appropriate funds from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying additional expenses of the Health Department's Mosquito Control Program and Health and Wellness Clinic.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,320.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for additional costs incurred in the Mosquito Control Program for 1989.

Section 2. That the sum of \$680.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for flu vaccine used in Bexley Health Department's Health and Wellness Clinics.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
