

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids and enter into a contract to purchase highway rock salt for the winter of 1989-1990, and to declare an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of highway rock salt in the approximate amount of 400 tons for the winter of 1989-1990.

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}.$  That the amount of \$18,000 was appropriated and set aside from the State Highway Fund by Ordinance No. 16-89 for the contract.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and so that bids can be secured and a contract executed prior to the onset of cold weather. This Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage by the Mayor.
