

ORDINANCE NO. 65-89

An Ordinance to establish the position of Recreation Activities Leader, to establish a salary, job responsibilities and qualifications, to amend Ordinance No. 17-89 accordingly and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the position of Recreation Activities Leader is hereby established to assist the Director of Recreation in planning, organizing and directing special events, projects, trips and activities of senior citizens, teens and young children and to provide other related duties as required.

Section 2. That the position shall have an annual salary of \$17,700 for the year 1989 and shall be entitled to all rights and benefits provided to salaried personnel as more specifically set forth in Ordinance No. 17-89.

Section 3. That the qualifications for the position of Recreation Activities Leader, the duties to be performed, and the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform such duties shall be consistent with the classification specifications set forth in the Position Classification Plan adopted by the Bexley Civil Service Commission in April of 1984 and as that plan is hereafter amended by said Commission.

Section 4. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 17-89 is hereby amended to add the position of Recreation Activities Leader to the schedule of positions.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide uninterrupted recreational programs to the public, and shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
