

ORDINANCE NO. 74-89

An Ordinance to make available to City employees the option to enroll in a health maintenance organization in accordance with state law, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute a contract with Physicians Health Plan of Ohio, Inc. for such purpose and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 1742.33, the City make available to and inform its employees of the option to enroll in Physicians Health Plan of Ohio, Inc. ("PHPO"), a health maintenance organization holding a valid certificate of authority to provide health care services in central Ohio.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with PHPO for such services in accordance with the proposal submitted to the City by PHPO.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to make such mandated option available to employees at the earliest possible date, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
