

ORDINANCE NO. 20 -90

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Pitometer Associates, Consulting Engineers, for the purpose of analyzing the Bexley water distribution system, to appropriate \$19,700.00 from the Water Fund and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is prudent to analyze the Bexley water distribution system to determine its adequacy and condition; and,

WHEREAS, Pitometer Associates is a well qualified firm with the instrumentation, experience and expertise necessary to collect and analyze field data on water distribution systems. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with Pitometer Associates for the purpose of analyzing the Bexley water distribution system.

Section 2. That the amount of \$19,700.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of paying for the study.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need for analysis of the Bexley water distribution system to determine the adequacy of the system prior to any future system alterations, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
