SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 34-90

An Ordinance to authorize the transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of recycling equipment and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$8,100.00 be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of recycling equipment and to declare an emergency.

Section 2. That the sum of \$8,100.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of one (1) compartmentalized trailer for the collection of recyclable material.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to begin a curbside/ alleyside recycling program at the earliest possible time, and that this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
