

ORDINANCE NO. 44-90

An Ordinance to authorize the City's participation in joint cooperative purchasing programs and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, opportunities exist by which the City may receive the advantage of lower prices resulting from large volume purchases of supplies, machinery, equipment and other articles by participating in joint bidding programs conducted by other Ohio governmental entities, Ohio Boards of Education and Ohio associations composed of governmental purchasers. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor may, where advantageous to the City, hereby participate in joint bidding programs for the purchase of supplies, machinery, equipment and other articles conducted by other Ohio governmental entities, Ohio Boards of Education and Ohio associations composed of governmental purchasers.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor shall participate in such joint purchasing programs only when the other Ohio governmental entities, Ohio Boards of Education or Ohio associations have procured and entered into contracts for purchase in accordance with the applicable competitive bidding provisions of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to enable the City to secure the savings from participation in the programs at the earliest possible date, and shall be in force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
