An Ordinance to appropriate \$44,120.00 from the Sewer Fund and to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into contracts for the construction of a sanitary sewer relief line and a storm sewer.

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to construct, at a cost of \$4,000.00, a sanitary sewer relief line for sewerage overflow from an existing City owned eight inch sanitary sewer line located in Parkview Avenue to a sanitary sewer line being constructed with private funds to service six homes that will be located on property known as 303 North Parkview Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the City has a need to correct a flooding situation in the first alley south of Broad Street between South Stanwood Road and South Roosevelt Avenue, and Agudas Achim Synagogue, a property owner adjacent to the alley, has agreed to participate in 50 percent of the \$40,120.00 cost of constructing a storm sewer. NOW. THEREFORE sewer. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$44,120.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the Sewer Fund for the purpose of constructing a storm sewer and sanitary sewer relief line as described above.

That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby <u>Section 2.</u> authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the construction of said storm and sanitary relief sewer lines.

 $\underline{\text{Section 3}}.$ That 50 percent of the \$40,120.00 cost of constructing the storm sewer will be reimbursed to the City by Agudas Achim Synagogue.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be Section 4. in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
