

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 63-90

An Ordinance to appropriate \$10,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund, \$4,700.00 from the Recreation Fund, \$25,000.00 from the Special Assessments Fund, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the following purposes:

Section 3. That \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Special Assessments Fund for the following purpose:
