

ORDINANCE NO. 65-90

An Ordinance to appropriate \$75,000 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of property located at 2248-2250 East Main Street, Bexley, Ohio, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute any and all documents required in connection with said purchase and the settlement of litigation styled as City of Bexley v. Kunkler and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$75,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing the property located at 2248-2250 East Main Street, Bexley, Ohio.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents which may, in the opinion of the City Solicitor, be required to effect said purchase and the settlement of litigation styled as City of Bexley v. Kunkler.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to effect settlement of pending litigation prior to the scheduled trial date, and shall be in force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
