ORDINANCE NO. 772-90

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with International Salt Company, Inc. to purchase highway rock salt for the winter of 1990-1991.

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley participated in a cooperative bid for highway rock salt with the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government; and,

WHEREAS, the bidding procedures used by Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government were in accordance with competitive bidding procedures; and,

WHEREAS, the successful bidder was International Salt Company, Inc. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with International Salt Company, Inc. for the purchase of highway rock salt in the approximate amount of 400 tons for the winter of 1990-1991.

<u>Section 2</u>. That the amount of \$18,000 was appropriated and set aside from the State Highway Fund by Ordinance No. 16-90 for the contract.

<u>Section 3</u>. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
