

ORDINANCE NO. 81-90

An Ordinance to appropriate \$5,900 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a repeater unit for the police communication system and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$5,900 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing one General Electric repeater unit required by the police communication system.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide for the uninterrupted operation of the police communication system, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
