ORDINANCE NO. <u>87</u>-90

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to sign an agreement on behalf of the City of Bexley, Ohio, with Ohio Waste Paper Company of 1960 S. Fourth Street, Columbus, Ohio, to service a curbside collection program for recyclable materials in the City of Bexley and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the curbside collection of recyclable materials benefits the City of Bexley by reducing the quantity of material placed for collection by City Sanitation Personnel and, therefore, also benefits the City of Bexley by reducing the cost per tonnage for refuse tipping fees.

WHEREAS, to have a successful curbside collection program it is necessary to have a single buyer for recyclable materials; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Waste Paper Company has serviced the collection of recyclable materials for a "drive" type recycling program in the City of Bexley; and,

WHEREAS, no other buyer is able to accept all recyclable materials collected in Bexley's curbside program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into an agreement with Ohio Waste Paper Company for purchase of items collected from the curbside recycling program in the City of Bexley.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this Ordinance is an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to enter into a contract effective January 1, 1991, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

The Company agrees to pay the City monthly and to provide monthly reports to the City on the amount of materials collected. If an invoice is rendered, the City agrees to pay the Company monthly after receipt of an invoice from the Company.

The term of this agreement is twelve (12) months beginning January 1, 1991. Following the end of the initial twelve (12) month term, the agreement will automatically renew for another period of twelve (12) months unless either party gives 30 days written notice of cancellation. Thereafter, either party may cancel this agreement with 30 days written notice to the other party.
