

ORDINANCE NO. 5-91

An Ordinance to authorize the reappropriation of \$6,161.90 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund for storm sewer improvements made in the first alley south of Broad Street between South Stanwood Road and South Roosevelt Avenue and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 56-90 appropriated \$40,000 for the construction of a storm sewer in the first alley south of Broad Street between South Stanwood Road and South Roosevelt Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, \$26,548.90 was spent for the construction during fiscal year 1990; and,

WHEREAS, at the end of fiscal year 1990, the remaining funds were returned to the unencumbered Sewer Fund; and,

WHEREAS, McCoy Excavating completed the storm sewer project, at a cost of \$32,710.80 of which \$6,161.90 has not been paid. NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$6,161.90 be, and the same hereby is, reappropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund for the final payment of the storm sewer construction.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to pay an outstanding obligation for work that has been completed and, therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
