

RESOLUTION NO. 6-91

A Resolution to authorize the Auditor to create a fund for Street Maintenance/Special Projects in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Chapter ~~4504~~<sup>5705</sup> and to declare an emergency.

That this fund is necessary for the segregation and control of special funds.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is created the Street Maintenance/Special Projects Fund.

Section 2. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to place all monies received into the Street Maintenance/Special Projects Fund. That the monies are to be used solely for the resurfacing and curb replacement of East Broad Street and East Main Street, as approved by the County Engineer.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare. That this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
