

ORDINANCE NO. 7-91

An Ordinance to transfer \$49,700 from the Swimming Pool Fund to the unencumbered General Fund, to terminate the Teen Center Fund and transfer the balance therein to the Recreation Fund and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$49,700 is hereby transferred from the Swimming Pool Fund to the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of reimbursing the General Fund for advancements made to the Swimming Pool Fund pursuant to Ordinance Nos. 9-87, 30-87, 41-87 and 49-87.

Section 2. That the Teen Center Fund is hereby terminated and all funds therein are hereby transferred to the Recreation Fund.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of replenishing the unencumbered General Fund and Recreation Fund for the purpose of paying current operating expenses of the City, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
