SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 9 -91

An Ordinance to amend Section 1060.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley to increase the rate for the collection and disposal of garbage, trash, yard trash and brush within the City and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

 $\underline{Section\ 1}.$ That Section 1060.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley is amended to read as follows:

1060.10 CHARGES; CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS ON PARTICULAR COLLECTIONS.

- (a) To provide necessary funds for equipment, personnel and other expenses in connection with the collection and disposal of garbage, trash, yard trash and brush in the City, a charge of -one-hundred-fifty-six--dollars-(\$156-00) ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$180.00) per year, payable quarterly in advance, commencing October-1;-1990-APRIL 1, 1991, is hereby levied and assessed for the collection and disposal of garbage, trash, yard trash and brush from each dwelling or family unit. Whenever service is between quarterly payment dates, a payment at the rate of one twelfth of the current annual charge per month, for the balance of the current quarterly period, shall be made before service is commenced. For periods of ten days or less in any one month, no charge shall be made, but eleven days or more shall be charged for a full month. No refund shall be made for any part of the quarterly payment if service is discontinued during such period.
- (b) The Director of Public Service is authorized, upon request of an owner or resident, to determine the conditions under which the City will collect and dispose of waste materials which do not constitute "trash", as defined in Section 1060.01, and to fix the charge to be made therefor, taking into consideration the availability of equipment, personnel and disposal facilities and the cost to the City of such service. He is also authorized to limit the amount of brush, tree and shrub trimmings which will be collected from subscribers without additional charge to such amount as he considers a normal or average amount per collection unit, and to contract with the subscribers for the collection and disposal of such excess materials, as hereinabove provided, for other waste materials.

<u>Section 2</u>. That existing Section 1060.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to implement the increase prior to the April, 1991 water billing period and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
