

ORDINANCE NO. 27(A)-91

An Ordinance to transfer \$31,000 from the General Fund to the Street Maintenance/Special Projects Fund to pay the City's share of the Main/Broad Street Paving and Curb Replacement Project and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$31,000 should be and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Street Maintenance/Special Projects Fund to pay the City's share of the Main/Broad Street Paving and Curb Replacement Project.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to encumber funds and execute the contract prior to the bid sale date of July 2, 1991, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
