An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$2,100.00 from the unencumbered Refuse Fund to be used for the purpose of promoting existing and proposed recycling programs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:
