ORDINANCE NO. <u>33</u>-91

An Ordinance to increase the sewer rate and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sewer rates charged by the City of Bexley to customers who are billed monthly shall be at the rate of \$19.00 per 1,000 cubic feet, commencing July 1, 1991.

Section 2. That the sewer rates charged by the City of Bexley to customers who are billed every three months shall be at the rate of \$19.00 per 1,000 cubic feet, commencing July 1, 1991.

Section 3. That all existing ordinances of the City of Bexley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the City of Columbus, Ohio has increased our sewer rate and it is necessary to increase our rate as soon as possible to compensate for the same, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
