

ORDINANCE NO. 35 -91

An Ordinance to appropriate \$418.52 from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the City's share of the costs of the Franklin County emergency warning system.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$418.52 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying amounts due to the Emergency Management Agency of Columbus and Franklin County, Ohio for user costs of the emergency warning system.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
