

ORDINANCE NO. 40 -91

An Ordinance to appropriate an additional amount of \$4,367.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase and installation of two underground fuel storage tanks and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 22-91 appropriated \$60,000.00 for the purchase and installation of two underground fuel storage tanks; and,

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid received for the purchase and installation of the tanks was \$64,367.00 which exceeds the original appropriation by \$4,367.00; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to accept this bid as it is unlikely a lower bid will be received if the project is rebid, and there are available funds in the Capital Improvement Fund to complete the purchase. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$4,367.00 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase and installation of two underground fuel storage tanks in accordance with bids received by the Service Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to replace the underground fuel storage tanks immediately to prevent further leaking of fuel from the tanks, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
