

ORDINANCE NO. 41 -91

An Ordinance to appropriate \$78,000 from the Water Fund to construct a water line, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute contracts for said project and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$78,000 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund for the purpose of constructing a water line under Main Street from South Drexel Avenue to Sheridan Avenue in accordance with the report of Pitometer Associates Engineers.


Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorize and directed to enter into contracts for the construction of said water line.


Section 3. That any contracts for the construction of said water line, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to construct said water line prior to making of improvements to Main Street, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor
