

ORDINANCE NO. 48 -91

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to execute a contract with G & G Cement Contractors for Main Street (from the west corporation line east to Drexel Avenue) curb replacement and street repaving project and to appropriate \$140,000.00 from the Street Maintenance Special Projects Fund, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to replace the curbs and repave Main Street from the west corporation line east to Drexel Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, G & G Cement Contractors were determined to be the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract with G & G Cement Contractors for the replacement of curbs and repaving of Main Street from the west corporation line east to Drexel Avenue.

Section 2. That the amount of \$140,000.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the Street Maintenance Special Projects Fund for the purpose of funding the Main Street curb replacement, street repaving project.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete the project during the 1991 construction season, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
