

ORDINANCE NO. 54 -91

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$15,000.00 to pay costs associated with the removal of contaminated soil found during the removal of existing underground gasoline storage tanks and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$15,000.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying costs associated with the removal of contaminated soil found during the removal of existing underground gasoline storage tanks.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to pay the costs for removal of the contaminated soil in a timely manner, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
