An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with North American Salt Company to purchase highway rock salt for the winter of 1991-1992.

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with North American Salt Company for the purchase of highway rock salt in the approximate amount of 400 tons for the winter of 1991-1992.

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}.$ That the amount of \$18,000 was appropriated and set aside from the State Highway Fund by Ordinance No. 18-91 for the contract.

 $\underline{\text{Section 3}}.$ That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
