

ORDINANCE NO. 58 91

An Ordinance to appropriate the amount of \$2,300 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paving the "new" city hall parking lot created by the demolition of the "Feedbag" building and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$2,300 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paving the parking lot.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the paving of the parking lot.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to complete the paving prior to inclement weather and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
