

ORDINANCE NO. 66 -91

An Ordinance to appropriate the amount of \$31,878.00 from the unencumbered Refuse Fund for the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources' share of the cost of a recycling truck and trailer and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received a grant in the amount of \$31,878.00 from the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the purchase of recycling materials collection equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources' share of the cost has been deposited with the City of Bexley unencumbered Refuse Fund. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$31,878.00 is hereby appropriated from the Refuse Fund for the purchase of a recycling truck and trailer.


Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of a recycling truck and trailer.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to purchase a recycling truck and trailer at the earliest possible date and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


