An Ordinance to appropriate \$5,400 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a telephone device for the deaf in requesting police assistance and related equipment for the Bexley Police Department and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$5,400 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a Superprint ESTDD Unit, a Model 5714 Digital Call Check Unit and recording tapes for the Bexley Police Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to assure compliance with certain requirements of the Americans With Disabilities Act on or before January 26, 1992, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
