

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 71-91

An Ordinance to appropriate \$24,000 to pay for engineering services related to the resurfacing and curb replacement project on Drexel Avenue between Broad Street and Main Street, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation will be resurfacing Drexel Avenue between Broad Street and Main Street in 1992; and,

WHEREAS, the City has applied for State Issue II funds to replace the curbs on Drexel Avenue between Broad Street and Main Street; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley is responsible for preparing engineering documents related to these projects. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to pay for engineering services related to the resurfacing and curb replacement project on Drexel Avenue between Broad Street and Main Street.

Section 2. That \$24,000 be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Street Construction and Repair Fund for the purpose of paying for engineering services related to the curb and resurfacing project on Drexel Avenue between Broad Street and Main Street.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete the engineering drawings at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
