

ORDINANCE NO. 72 -91

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to solicit proposals for the purchase of recyclable materials from the curbside collection program in the City of Bexley, to execute an agreement with the firm offering the best proposal, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the curbside collection of recyclable materials benefits the City of Bexley by reducing the quantity of material placed for collection by City Sanitation Personnel and, therefore, also benefits the City of Bexley by reducing the cost per tonnage for refuse tipping fees.

WHEREAS, to have a successful curbside collection program it is necessary to have a single buyer for recyclable materials. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to solicit proposals for the purchase of items collected from the curbside recycling program in the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to execute an agreement with the firm offering the best proposal for the purchase of items collected from the curbside recyclable program in the City of Bexley.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to enter into a contract effective January 1, 1992, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
