

ORDINANCE NO. 76 -91

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$18,000 for the purchase of water meters and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, four construction projects in the City of Bexley (Columbus School for Girls, Sunrise of Bexley, Capital University and Bexley Public Library) require specialized water meters; and,

WHEREAS, it is the City's policy to require that all water meters be purchased from the City of Bexley Water Department; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Bexley Water Department to purchase the meters prior to their sale to the owners of the above names projects. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$18,000 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purchase of four specialized water meters for use at Columbus School for Girls, Sunrise of Bexley, Capital University and Bexley Public Library.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and, therefore, shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
