

ORDINANCE NO. 2-92

An Ordinance to appropriate \$4,900.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund to pay for termination of water lines to the Nelson Road Water Meter Pit, to authorize the contracting for said project, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Nelson Road Water Meter Pit is no longer in service; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable to terminate the water lines to the meter pit to prevent potential leaks; and,

WHEREAS, quotations have been solicited from contractors for the work. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$4,900.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of paying for the termination of water lines to the Nelson Road Water Meter Pit.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract on behalf of the City with the Woodward Excavating Company, which gave the lowest and best quote, to perform this work.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete the work during frozen ground conditions to cause the least disturbance to yards of properties affected, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
