#### AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 14-92

# By: John M. Brennan

To establish rates of pay for all salaried employees, hourly employees, City Attorney, Parking Control Officer, Animal Control Officer, Police Chief, Police Lieutenant, and Police Sergeants of the City of Bexley, effective as of January 1, 1992, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the elected officials of the City of Bexley are to be paid in the manner prescribed by the Charter and Ordinances.

#### Section 2.

A. That the Police Chief, Police Lieutenant, Police Sergeants, Parking Control Officer, and Animal Control Officer will be paid according to Schedule I as follows:

The Supervisors of Recreation are hereby determined by virtue of the duties to be performed by them to be assistant department heads exempt from the Classified service.

The Secretary to the Service Department, Secretary to the Building Department, Secretary to the Recreation Department, Secretary to the Police Department, Clerk of Courts/Administrative Aide to the Chief of Police, and Water Department Account Clerk 2, will be paid annual salaries based on the stated years of continuous employment as follows:

D. That the City Attorney, the Health Commissioner, and the Sanitarian will be paid according to Schedule IV as follows:

# SCHEDULE IV

The City Attorney will be paid a retainer of \$27,720 and expenses plus fees at the hourly rate for the lawyer performing service for representation of the City before the Bexley Mayor's Court; Bexley Civil Service Commission and in other legal proceedings, to be paid monthly or at the discretion of the Auditor. This annual fee does not include representation in litigation involving the Bexley School District.

The Health Commissioner will be paid an annual salary of \$8,995. Such salary will be paid in 26 pays per year.

The Sanitarian will be paid at an hourly rate of 9.72 per hour, invoiced monthly to the City of Bexley, and benefits will be as set forth in Ordinance No. 15-90, as amended in part by Ordinance No. 49-90.

Section 3. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect as of January 1, 1992.

Section 4. That, until and unless changed, the hours of work, working conditions and fringe benefits of all employees of the City of Bexley shall be set forth in Ordinance No. 15-90, as amended in part by Ordinance No. 49-90.

Section 5. That in order to assure uninterrupted City services, this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
