A Resolution to declare the intention of City Council in asking for an increase in the City income tax.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That it is the intention of this Council in asking for an increase in the City income tax that, if approved, the additional monies received in the future from the Ohio Estate Tax would be used predominately for capital improvements and/or debt reduction and not the general operating expenses of the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
