A Resolution supporting the declaration of October as Ohio Recycle Month.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has declared the month of October to be Ohio Recycle Month; and,

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Authority of Central Ohio encourages and promotes recycling as an essential component of an integrated solid waste management program; and,

WHEREAS, the remaining capacity of the Franklin County Landfill is five years and communities have been encouraged to provide collection programs for recyclables to achieve the 40% waste reduction goal of the draft Franklin County Solid Waste Management Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the waste reduction goal will not be attained without the participation of the residents in the City of Bexley; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley is committed to preserving the remaining landfill capacity in Franklin County. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Bexley supports the declaration of October as Ohio Recycle Month.

Section 2. That all City of Bexley residents are encouraged to reduce the quantity of wastes thrown away by recycling.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
