

ORDINANCE NO. 27 -92

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Noble's, Inc. to assist the Bexley Police Department in the enforcement of traffic and safety laws by providing tow-truck and storage services for impounded vehicles and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor should be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with Nobles, Inc., a copy of which contract is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten to provide tow-truck and storage services on behalf of the Bexley Police Department for vehicles impounded for violation of the traffic and safety laws of the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That said contract shall be for an indefinite period, subject to termination by either party by giving 60 days written notice thereof to the other party to the contract.

Section 3. That said contractor is to be paid for its services by the City from funds annually appropriated from the General Fund upon the presentation of invoices pursuant to the contract requirements, and that all towing, impounding and storage fees assessed and collected by the Bexley Police Department or by the City are to be paid into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the expiration of the existing towing service contract, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
