An Ordinance to approve a memorandum of understanding granting a 5% wage increase to full-time police radio dispatchers effective January 1, 1992, to authorize the Mayor and Chief of Police to sign the memorandum and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the memorandum of understanding amending Section 14.1 of the labor agreement between the City and the Communication Workers of America, Local 4320 with respect to fulltime police radio dispatchers is hereby approved in the form attached to this Ordinance and incorporated herein by this reference, which amendment grants a 5% increase effective January 1, 1992 in the wage levels specified in Section 14.1 of the labor agreement.

<u>Section 2</u>. That the Mayor and Chief of Police are hereby authorized and directed to execute the memorandum of understanding on behalf of the City.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide for the uninterrupted operation of the City police department, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
