

ORDINANCE NO. 30 -92

An Ordinance to adopt and execute the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission's revised financial provisions of the Articles of Agreement.

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley is a government member of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC); and,

WHEREAS, on December 19, 1991, MORPC adopted a resolution in support of revisions to the Financial Provisions of its Articles of Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the revised Financial Provisions provide more flexibility by replacing the fixed dues rate with the requirement that the Commission adopt a fee schedule each July for the upcoming year and establish a maximum fee schedule for the next five years; and,

WHEREAS, said amendments were developed by the Dues Task Force and approved by the Administrative Committee and the full MORPC Board; and,

WHEREAS, in order for MORPC to implement the amendment to the Articles of Agreement, a majority of member governments must approve said amendment through legislative action. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That revised Financial Provisions of the Articles of Agreement, dated December 19, 1991, (a copy is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A) of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) be and are hereby adopted.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute the amendment to the Articles of Agreement on behalf of City Council.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety in this city, such emergency arising from the need to adopt said revised Financial Provisions of the Articles of Agreement in order to facilitate the ratification process prior to June 30, 1992, and shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
