

ORDINANCE NO. 47-92

An Ordinance to transfer \$25,000 from the Swimming Pool Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate \$25,000 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of remodeling the outdoor rest room facility in Jeffrey Park, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into contracts for such project, to authorize the reimbursement of the Swimming Pool Fund from the unencumbered General Fund when funds become available for such purpose and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$25,000 is hereby transferred from the Swimming Pool Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That \$25,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of remodeling the outdoor rest room facility in Jeffrey Park.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts for such project and that the contracts authorized hereby, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to reimburse the Swimming Pool Fund by a funds transfer from the unencumbered General Fund when, as and if the Auditor determines that there is an adequate surplus in the unencumbered General Fund available for such purpose.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of providing adequate public rest room facilities at the earliest practicable date, which shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
